

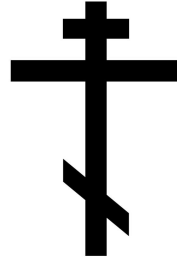





Kontakion of the Pre-feast of the Cross - Tone 4



The heav-ens surpassed the sun in bril-liance, for the cross illumines ev-'ry-thing
by its ra-di-ance. En-light-en our minds and sen-ses by its pow'r.
O true Lov-er of all of us, Sav-ior of all cre-a-tion.
We have the cross as an ar-mor of peace and a tro-phy of light.

Prokeimenon of the Resurrection - Tone 7 (Psalm 28:11,1,2):

The Lord will give strength to his peo - ple; the Lord
will bless, will bless his peo - ple with peace.

Verse: Bring to the Lord, you sons of God; bring to the Lord glory and honor.
And then immediately:

Prokeimenon of the Cross - Tone 7 (Psalm 98:5,1):

Ex - alt the Lord, the Lord our God and wor-ship at his
foot - stool; for he is ho - ly, for he is ho - ly.

Alleluia of the Resurrection - Tone 7 (Psalm 91:2,3):

Verse: It is good to give thanks to the Lord and to sing praises to your name, O Most High.
Verse: To proclaim your mercy in the morning, and your faithfulness throughout the night.
